Sir/Madam,

The Examination Committee in its Meeting Held on 30.11.2009 has approved the following changes in the registration fee structure which has also been ratified by the Governing Body at its meeting held on 23.12.2009:

- Registration fee in Class IX w.e.f 2010-11 session has been enhanced to Rs. 100/- per student from Rs.50/-per student.
- Registration fee of Rs.100/- per student will be charged in Class XI w.e.f 2010-11 session.
- Fee for duplicate registration card has been enhanced to Rs.100/- from Rs.50/- in Class IX and will be levied at Rs.100/- in Class XI.
- Schedule for receipt of registration forms each year will be as under:




