Format of Co-scholastic certificate to be issued by the schools and upgradation of grades in Scholastic in respect of candidates of Class X Examination 2017 -reg

Dear Principal,

As you are aware that the result of Class-X Examination, 2017 has already been declared by the Board. The Board has collected Co-scholastic grades awarded to candidates while collecting FA/SA data. For Co-scholastic areas, certificate will be issued separately by the school in the format per Appendix A.

While preparing the result, grades obtained by the candidates have been upgraded(and marked as ** against the subject) based on the grades in Co-scholastic certificate, as per the following scheme:

- a) Those Students who get total grade points in co-scholastic areas/ activities in the range 53-65 have been upgraded to the next higher grade in two subjects in scholastic areas.
- b) Those students who get total grade points in the range 40-52, have been upgraded to the next higher grade in one subject in scholastic area.
- c) The upscaling of Grade in Scholastic Areas is applicable in Main Subject only (i.e. excluding Additional 6th Subject).
- d) No Grade is to be upscaled twice.
- e) No upscaling is done if the Grade obtained in the subject is E2 or A1.
- f) Upscaling is done from lowest grade to next higher grade and so on. (Example: E1 be upscaled to D, D to C2, C2 to C1, C1 to B2, B2 to B1, B1 to A2 and A2 to A1)
- g) In case of tie in Grades in two or more subjects (i.e. if Grades obtained are same), the upscaling be done in following order:
 - · Higher marks obtained in the subject be preferred
 - In case of tie in marks, higher marks obtained in Summative Assessments (SA1+SA2)
 - In case of tie in Summative Assessments marks, higher marks obtained in Formative Assessments (FA1+FA2+FA3+FA4)



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Schools should encourage students who win I/II positions/prizes in competitions held at state level and/or participation in competitions held at national/international level organised by a body recognized by the state/central Government/CBSE. Any competition organised by such agencies related to the co-scholastic areas/ activities should be included in the Co-scholastic certificate.

It is to add that as informed vide circular No. Acad-05/2017 dated 31/1/2017 there will be no upscaling / upgradation of scholastic grades for the students appearing in Class X Board Examination 2018 and onwards.
