CBSE LAUNCHES ONLINE CAREER GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING PORTAL FOR STUDENTS

All the Heads of affiliated schools

Dear Madam/Sir

The CBSE is pleased to announce the launch of a dedicated online portal on career guidance and counselling. The career portal cbsecareerguidance.com offers information on careers, college directories, courses, scholarships and competitive entrance exams.

All CBSE School students of class IX-XII can sign up on the portal with their details and access a personalised career dashboard. The portal will also be accessible to teachers and administrators. Currently each student through individual career dashboard will be able to access:

- o 560+ careers (English, Hindi & 8 other languages)
- 25,000 colleges and vocational institutes spanning over 3 lakh courses
- 1200 scholarships
- o 1150 Entrance Exams
- The portal with the entire career curriculum will be offered to students at <u>no</u> <u>cost</u>.

The CBSE Career Guidance and Counselling portal:

- Is gender inclusive
- Informs career options for special ability students
- Uses an interactive approach to engage with the students

As a next step, CBSE will create Career Counsellor/Teacher Dashboards and therefore you are requested to send details of 2 counsellors or Teachers preferably one teaching class IX-X and the second teaching class XI and XII. These counsellors /teachers will be trained on the portal through a digital training session of 1 hour 30 minutes duration.

 All counsellors /teachers must register themselves on the portal www.cbsecareerguidance.com to acquaint themselves beforehand.



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- The teachers /counsellors will be given a personal dashboard to access the entire career curriculum and use it to guide the students for their career queries.
- The details of two teachers may be sent through the Google Form which will be made available at <u>www.cbse.nic.in</u> by 20th August 2021 positively.
- The training will commence from 10th September to 10th October 2021. Region wise schedules will be intimated separately to all schools.

Dedicated Career Guidance and Counselling Centres in each School

CBSE will set up a dedicated Career Guidance & Counselling Information Centre for regular interaction and coordination with schools.

Schools should encourage students to use the portal www.cbsecareerguidance.com extensively. CBSE will facilitate the students with ready reckoners such as video demos and step wise instructions on how to navigate through the portal.
