**Subject: National Teachers' Conference (NTC) 2026 on Computational Thinking and Understanding AI (CT & Understanding AI)**

Further to the Notification No. TRG-2 dated 9.04.2026 assigning 'Computational Thinking (CT) and Understanding AI' as the theme for Teachers' Training for 2026-2027, the Board announces **National Teachers' Conference 2026 on Computational Thinking and Understanding AI**. The Conference aims to bring together educators, thought leaders, and practitioners to celebrate and exchange the best practices in CT and AI. It offers an opportunity to explore pathways for nurturing innovation, critical thinking, and ethical decision-making capacities among learners. It gives a huge space for collaborative learning by listening to eminent domain experts and the best paper presenters on Sub-Themes listed below:

1. Foundations of Computational Thinking (CT) and AI Readiness
2. From Play to Abstraction: Progressive Pedagogy for Computational Thinking
3. Mathematics as the Cornerstone of Computational Thinking and AI Readiness
4. Interdisciplinary Connections: CT across Subjects at Middle Stage
5. AI in Real-World Contexts
6. Assessment and Pedagogy in CT and AI
7. Ethics and Responsible use of AI

**Who can participate:** Any Teacher/Principal/Counsellor/Special Educator of a CBSE affiliated school can participate as a delegate and/or case paper presenter on being shortlisted at the national level.

The last date for online registration is **31<sup>st</sup> August, 2026**. The link for online registration will be closed once the required number of participants is attained, so do not wait until the last date. It will be strictly on first come first serve basis. **Conference Dates: 20 -21 November 2026 (Friday and Saturday)**

**Conference City: Pune (Maharashtra)**

**Participation Fee:** Participants are required to pay the following fee at the time of registration. The fee shall be payable online. The conference fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

- Rs. 5000/- for Principals of CBSE affiliated schools across the country
- Rs. 10,000/- for Principals/Teachers of CBSE affiliated foreign schools
- Rs. 2000/- for Teachers teaching in CBSE affiliated schools across the country

Lunch and refreshment shall be served at the venue during the conference. The participants have to make their own stay and travel arrangements. The information/updates on Conference will be available on CBSE website. The participants are requested to visit CBSE website regularly. The date of Conference is final. However, in case of change due to any compelling reason, the participants have to attend the conference as per the revised schedule. No request for refund on the basis of any such change in the schedule will be considered.

**Certification:** All participants who attend the conference shall receive a Certificate of Participation. Theme-wise Best Case Paper Certificate shall also be given to the participants based on the recommendation of selection committee at the HQ Level.

## Procedure for Case Paper Selection for the Conference:

1. With the view to promote innovative and practice driven endeavours in CBSE schools, the case papers for NTC 2026 would be picked up from amongst the best papers in the CT & AI – DLD workshops held at district level.
2. Schools have already been requested to organise District Level Deliberations (DLDs) on CT & AI in the form of one-day workshop vide [CBSE Notification No. TRG-2 dated 9.04.2026](#).
3. Those willing to present paper in the NTC 2026 must participate in the CT & AI DLDs as planned in their districts by the District Training Coordinators (DTCs)/Sahodaya Functionaries in consultation with the respective CoEs as per [Guidelines](#) issued.
4. The best three papers received from the CoEs on different sub-themes would be examined by an Expert Committee at the National level to select the final papers for presentation in the NTC 2026. Evaluation criteria at the national level remain the same as outlined in the [Guidelines](#). Results would be announced one or two weeks before the conference dates. The **three best papers** in each sub-theme will be considered. The 1<sup>st</sup> best paper will qualify for presentation in the NTC fixed on **20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> November 2026**. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> best paper will have poster presentation.
