विषय : कक्षा 10वीं एवं 12वीं की बोर्ड परीक्षा - 2026 के लिए डेट शीट संबंधी।

महोदया/महोदय,

2025 की परीक्षाओं के परिणाम घोषित करते समय, सीबीएसई ने घोषणा की थी कि वर्ष 2026 में कक्षा 10वीं और 12वीं की परीक्षाएँ 17 फरवरी 2026 से प्रारंभ होंगी। यह भी सूचित किया गया था कि 2026 में सीबीएसई, राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति (NEP-2020) में की गई सिफारिशों के अनुसार, कक्षा 10वीं के लिए दो बोर्ड परीक्षाएँ आयोजित की जाएँगी।

कक्षा 9वीं और 11वीं के पंजीकरण डेटा के आधार पर, सीबीएसई ने पहली बार 2026 की परीक्षाओं के लिए परीक्षाओं के आरंभ होने से 146 दिन पहले एक प्रारंभिक अस्थायी डेट शीट 24.09.2025 को जारी की थी इसका उद्देश्य यह था कि सभी संबंधित पक्ष (stakeholders) अपनी तैयारियाँ उसी के अनुसार कर सकें।

सभी विद्यालयों द्वारा अपनी विद्यार्थियों की सूची (एलओसी) जमा कर दी गई है एवं अब सीबीएसई के पास विषय संयोजनों का अंतिम डेटा उपलब्ध है इसलिए, सीबीएसई ने 17 फरवरी 2026 से प्रारंभ होने वाली परीक्षाओं के लिए डेट शीट तैयार कर ली है — अर्थात् परीक्षाओं के आरंभ होने से 110 दिन पूर्व। डेट शीट तैयार करते समय निम्नलिखित बातों का ध्यान रखा गया है: —

 दोनों कक्षाओं में विद्यार्थियों द्वारा सामान्यतः लिए जाने वाले दो विषयों के बीच पर्याप्त अंतराल (गैप) दिया गया है।

2. कक्षा 12 के विद्यार्थियों के लिए आयोजित की जाने वाली प्रवेश परीक्षाओं की तिथियों को ध्यान में रखा गया है, और बोर्ड परीक्षाएँ प्रवेश परीक्षाओं से काफी पहले समाप्त करने का प्रयास किया गया है। इससे विद्यार्थिओं को बोर्ड और प्रवेश दोनों परीक्षाओं की बेहतर समय-प्रबंधन में सहायता मिलेगी।

 मूल्यांकन के दौरान, सभी विषयों के शिक्षक एक साथ और लंबे समय तक अपने विद्यालय से दूर नहीं रहेंगे।

4. डेट शीट तैयार करते समय 40,000 से अधिक विषय संयोजनों को ध्यान में रखते हुए डेट शीट तैयार की गई है, जिससे यह सुनिश्चित किया जा सके कि एक विद्यार्थी द्वारा प्रस्तावित दो विषयों की परीक्षाएँ एक ही तिथि पर न हों।

5. परीक्षाएँ प्रातः 10:30 बजे (भारतीय मानक समय - IST) से शुरु होंगी।

पहली बार, डेट शीट परीक्षाओं के आरंभ होने से लगभग 110 दिन पहले जारी की गई है। यह स्कूलों द्वारा अभ्यर्थियों की सूची (एलओसी) समय पर जमा करने के कारण संभव हो पाया। डेट शीट के जल्दी जारी करने के निम्नलिखित लाभ होंगे: –

 विद्यार्थी अपनी परीक्षा की तैयारी पहले से शुरू कर सकेंगे, जिससे उन्हें परीक्षा की चिंता से उबरने और परीक्षाओं में अपने प्रदर्शन को बेहतर बनाने में मदद मिलेगी।

- परीक्षाओं में सम्मिलित होने वाले अभ्यर्थियों के परिवार तथा शिक्षक, परीक्षा तिथियों और मूल्यांकन कार्यक्रम को ध्यान में रखते हुए, गर्मी की छुट्टियों के दौरान अपने भ्रमण योजना बना सकेंगे।
- शिक्षक लंबे समय तक अपने स्कूल से दूर नहीं रहेंगे, जिससे गैर-बोर्ड कक्षाओं की पढ़ाई बाधित नहीं होगी।

स्कूल बोर्ड कक्षाओं के लिए बेहतर ढंग से योजना बना सकेंगे।

- 5. परीक्षा केंद्र के रूप में निर्धारित किए गए स्कूलों के पास अपने स्कूलों की गतिविधियों की योजना बनाने के लिए पर्याप्त समय मिलेगा।
- 6. यह सुनिश्चित करने के लिए कि जे.ई.ई. मुख्य (JEE Main) और सीबीएसई परीक्षाएँ एक ही समय पर न हों, एनटीए को जे.ई.ई. मुख्य आवेदन पत्र में कक्षा 11 के विद्यार्थी को पंजीकरण संख्या भरना आवश्यक होगा। इस संबंध में, सभी विद्यालयों से अनुरोध है कि वे अपने कक्षा 11 के छात्रों को उनकी पंजीकरण संख्या उपलब्ध कराएँ।

Subject: Date Sheet for Class X and XII for Board Examinations -2026-reg

Madam/Sir,

When declaring the results of examinations 2025, CBSE announced that the examinations of both Class X and XII in 2026 will commence from 17.02.2026. It was also informed that in 2026, CBSE will conduct two Board examinations for Class X as per the recommendations made in NEP-2020.

Based on the registration data of Class IX and Class XI, CBSE, for the first time released a tentative Date Sheet for 2026 examinations on 24.09.2025 i.e. 146 days before the start of examinations so that stakeholders could make their preparations accordingly.

As all schools have submitted their LOC and CBSE now has final data of subject combinations offered by the students, hence, CBSE has prepared the Date Sheet for the examinations to be scheduled from 17.02.2026 onwards i.e. 110 days prior to start of the examinations. While preparing the Date sheet, the following have been taken into consideration: -

- 1. A sufficient gap has been given between two subjects generally offered by a student in both classes.
- The date of conduct of entrance examinations meant for the students of Class XII have been taken into consideration and efforts have been made to complete the examinations much before the entrance examinations. This will help the students in better time management for both the Board and entrance examinations.
- 3. During evaluation, teachers of all subjects will not stay away from their school simultaneously and for a longer period.
- 4. The date sheet has been prepared by avoiding more than 40,000 subject combinations to ensure that no two subjects' examinations offered by a student fall on the same date.
- 5. The time of the start of the examinations will be at 10.30 AM (IST).

For the first time, the date sheets have been issued nearly 110 days before the start of the examinations. This could have been possible because of the timely submission of LOC by the schools. An early release of the date sheet will have the following benefits: -

- 1. Students will be able to start their examination preparations well in advance which will help them overcome examination anxiety and improve their performance in the examinations.
- 2. Families of the students appearing for the examinations and the teachers will be able to plan their visits during the summer vacations keeping in view the examination dates and the evaluation schedule.
- 3. Teachers will not be away from their school for a longer time, hence, the studies of non-board classes will not be hampered.
- 4. The schools will be able to plan well for the Board classes.
- 5. The schools fixed as an examination centre will have sufficient time to plan activities of their schools accordingly.
- 6. To ensure that the JEE (Main) and CBSE examinations of the students do not coincide, NTA will require the Registration number of the student of Class XI to be filled in the JEE (Main) application. Accordingly, all the schools are requested to provide the registration number of Class XI to their students applying for JEE(Main).
