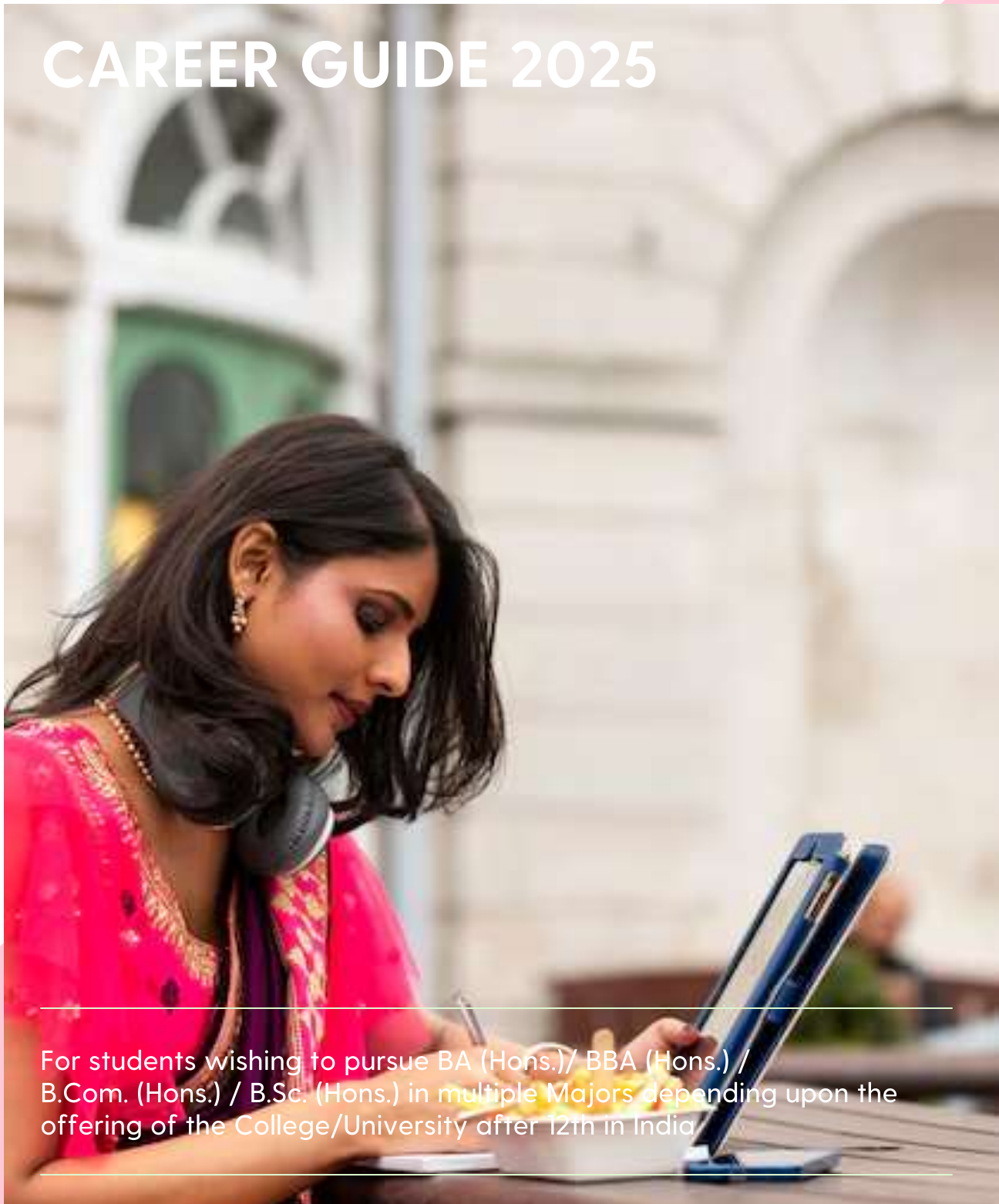

What is Liberal Studies?

Liberal Education is a term used for a multi-disciplinary approach to education. It emphasizes a learning system of education which provides a choice in courses that are varied and allows a student to explore multiple disciplines and discover what drives them the most.

In India, the Liberal Education is a newer concept. Liberal Education encompasses exposure in academic subjects such as Humanities, Commerce, Management, Pure Science and Performing Arts.

Typical Subjects in Liberal Studies:

- **Humanities:** Literature, philosophy, history, languages, and arts.
- **Social Sciences:** Sociology, psychology, political science, economics, and anthropology.
- **Natural Sciences:** Basic concepts in biology, chemistry, physics, and environmental science.
- **Mathematics:** Fundamental mathematical principles, often with an emphasis on logic and reasoning.
- **Fine Arts:** Music, theater, visual arts, and other forms of creative expression.

As a student in a Liberal Education, you become an intellectual explorer. The dictionary definition of “explorer” is “somebody who travels to distant or unfamiliar places to find out more about them.” This is a fairly accurate description of a liberal education. As a student in school of liberal education, you can now embark on that journey and ask challenging questions, find out what really matters to you, learn about the world as it is and the world as you think it ought to.

In India, Liberal Arts education is a typically 4-year Bachelor program in which students are exposed to mixture of subjects in the first two years and later allowed to take up a specialization in the form of a Major and minor subject areas. One taking up Commerce/ Management/ Humanities/ Science based Major specialization gets a B.Com. (Hons.)/ BBA (Hons.)/ BA (Hons.)/ B.Sc. (Hons.) degree respectively.

Career Prospects after Education in Liberal Studies

Accountant

An accountant is a person who records business transactions on behalf of an organization, reports on company performance to management, and issues financial statements.

Actuary

Actuaries are problem solvers and strategic thinkers, who use their mathematical skills to help measure the probability and risk of future events. They use these skills to predict the financial impact of these events on a business and their clients.

Advertising Representative

An advertising sales representative is responsible for getting advertising deals for their companies by selling packages to clients in media organizations. His/her job description entails selling available spaces and airtime to companies who have products and services to advertise in the organization's print or electronic medium.

Anchor

An anchor presents news stories on radio and television news broadcasts. He or she introduces reporters' videotaped and live reports, analyzes and selects stories, and interviews guests.

Auditor

Auditors are specialists who review the accounts of companies and organizations to ensure the validity and legality of their financial records. They can also act in an advisory role to recommend possible risk aversion measures and cost savings that could be made.

Aviation Manager

Aviation Managers work at airlines, airports, or other businesses within the aviation or aerospace industry, such as aircraft manufacturers.

Brand Manager

Brand Manager is responsible for adapting a brand strategy for a company's target market. As the 'brand guardian', brand managers maintain brand integrity across all

company marketing initiatives and communications, and may manage a portfolio of products.

Budget Consultant

Budget consultants, also called budget analysts, help individuals and organizations manage their finances by controlling spending and setting up budgets. They spend much of their time working by themselves, gathering and analyzing data, then preparing financial proposals.

Business Analyst

Analyst involved in the design or modification of business systems or IT systems. The analyst interacts with the business stakeholders and subject matter experts in order to understand their problems and needs.

Caption Writer

Caption Writer writes captions to describe music and background noises. Watches production and reviews captions simultaneously to determine which caption phrases require editing. Enters commands to synchronize captions with dialogue and place on the screen.

Content Writer

Content writers are professional writers who produce engaging content for online use. They're Internet-savvy individuals who create articles, blog posts, and other forms of written Web material.

Copywriter

Copywriters are employed by agencies both permanently and on a freelance basis to develop advertising concepts. They mainly deliver the words and verbal content that accompanies the visual elements.

Curator

A Curator is traditionally a preserver or keeper of cultural heritage institutions, working mainly at museums, galleries, libraries, etc. As a result of their heightened sense of care for things, curators are content specialists involved with the collection and interpretation of heritage materials.

Editor
Editors plan, revise, and coordinate material for publication in newspapers, magazines, books, or websites. They review story ideas and determine what material is most likely to please readers and offer suggestions to improve the product and suggest headlines and titles.
Entrepreneur/Businessman
An entrepreneur is a person who sets up his own new line of business, with financial risks hoping for profits. He is the pioneer of individuals working under him and is responsible for coming up with new ideas and strategies for the benefit of the organization as a whole. You can be called an entrepreneur if you engage in any scalable startup, small business which grows towards the creation of an entire organization. An Entrepreneur and a Businessman are not the same. A businessman works in commerce, especially at the executive level. It is not important for this person to come up with innovative ideas or business line. It just takes an already running business line to get started with.
Event Manager
Professionals who plan any event from start to finish according to requirements, target audience and objectives. They come up with suggestions to enhance the event's success and prepare budgets and ensure adherence.
Finance Analyst
Financial Analysts researches macroeconomic and microeconomic conditions along with company fundamentals to make business, sector and industry recommendations. They often recommend a course of action, such as to buy or sell a company's stock based upon its overall current and predicted strength.
Finance Planner
A Financial Planner, also called a personal financial advisor, works with individuals and businesses to guide them in making budgetary, savings and investment decisions. They need good communication and interpersonal skills in addition to financial knowledge.
Financial Portfolio Manager
A portfolio manager is a person or group of people responsible for investing a mutual, exchange traded or closed-end fund's assets, implementing its investment strategy,

and managing day-to-day portfolio trading. A portfolio manager is one of the most important factors to consider when looking at fund investing.

Hospitality and Tourism Managers

Hospitality and tourism management is a multidisciplinary field that prepares people with the interest, experience, and training for management positions in the food, accommodations, and tourism industry. Tourism management might also include the enterprises, associations, and public authorities that market tourism services to potential travelers.

Human Resources Manage

Human Resources Managers plan, direct, and coordinate the administrative functions of an organization. They oversee the recruiting, interviewing, and hiring of new staff; consult with top executives on strategic planning; and serve as a link between an organization's management and its employees.

Interpreters & Translators

An interpreter is a person specially trained to convert oral messages from one language to another. A translator is a person specially trained to convert written text from one language to another.

Investment Banker

Investment Bankers are individuals who help companies, organizations and clients manage and grow their financial assets. They help companies make sound decisions when it comes to investing their assets with the motive of increasing the value of their investments.

Journalist

A journalist is trained to gather, analyze, and report on news and current events. They use various sources to investigate and report on stories, including interviews with sources, research, and observations. Journalists can work in a variety of media, including print, television, radio, and online platforms.

Market Research Analyst

Market Research Analysts gather and analyze data on consumers and competitors.

Market research analysts study market conditions to examine potential sales of a product or service. They help companies understand what products people want, who will buy them, and at what price.

Marketing Manager

A Marketing Manager manages the marketing of a business or product. They can be responsible for several services or products, or be in charge of a single product. A Marketing Manager needs to have an outgoing, gregarious, and spontaneous nature.

Merchant Bankers

Merchant bank refers to a financial institution that conducts underwriting, loan services, financial advising, and fundraising services for large corporations and high-net-worth individuals. Merchant bankers are experts in international trade, which makes them specialists in dealing with multinational corporations. Unlike retail or commercial banks, merchant banks do not provide financial services to the general public.

Political Scientist

Political scientists study the origin, development, and operation of political systems. They research political ideas and analyze governments, policies, political trends, and related issues.

Portfolio Manager

A Portfolio Manager is a person or group of people responsible for investing a mutual, exchange-traded or closed-end fund's assets, implementing its investment strategy and managing day-to-day portfolio trading.

Project Manager

A project manager is a professional who organises, plans, and executes projects while working within restraints like budgets and schedules. Project managers are in charge of leading teams, defining goals, communicating with stakeholders, and seeing a project through to its closure.

Public Relation Manager

PR managers create and maintain a favorable public image for their employer or client by communicating programs, accomplishments and/or points of view.

Radio Jockey
A Radio Jockey is a media professional with strong interpersonal skills, they provide entertainment to the listeners through the music they play or by conveying messages in an attractive and sophisticated way.
Real Estate Manager
Real Estate Managers oversee the operational aspects of commercial and residential properties and are responsible for maintaining the premises and increasing their value
Reporters
News Reporters and correspondents (also known as journalists), gather news and information to keep the public informed about important events. Newspapers, magazines, television and radio stations rely on news correspondents to keep their readers, viewers and listeners informed.
Retail Manager
Retail Managers are responsible for every aspect of the day-to-day supervision of retail outlets, including sales, staff, stock and resources management.
Sales Manager
A Sales Manager is responsible for leading and guiding a team of sales people in an organization. They set sales goals & quotas, build a sales plan, analyze data, assign sales training and sales territories.
Screenwriter
A Screenplay writer, scriptwriter or scenarist is a writer who practices the craft of screenwriting, writing screenplays on which mass media, such as films, television programs and video games, are based.
Social Media Manager
Professional who develop relevant content topics to reach the company's target customers, create, curate, and manage all published content (images, video and written) and monitor, listen and respond to users in a "Social" way while cultivating leads and sales.

Social Worker

Social Workers are responsible for helping individuals, families, and groups of people to cope with problems they're facing to improve their lives. They meet with clients to help assess their needs and goals, maintaining case files in the process. They advocate for the wellbeing of those clients, and they may work with other professionals in that client's life to create a comprehensive wellbeing plan. Some social workers have specific titles based on their expertise in a subject.

Sociologist

Sociologists study human behavior, interaction, and organization. They observe the activity of social, religious, political, and economic groups, organizations, and institutions. They examine the effect of social influences, including organizations and institutions, on different individuals and groups.

Supply Chain Manager

Supply Chain Managers work with external partners to procure parts and raw materials needed to produce the product, create the inventory, and sell the product to outside markets. These professionals evaluate suppliers and negotiate contracts with vendors.

Talent Manager

Talent managers help shape their clients' careers and guide artists toward new opportunities. They set up performances and public appearances, introduce clients to agents and offer advice on contract negotiations. Some managers perform multiple duties by acting as managers, agents and publicists.
