#### **CBSE DECLARES CLASS XII EXAMINATION RESULTS 2026**

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), one of the largest Boards globally in terms of student participation, has successfully conducted the Class XII examinations for its affiliated schools in India and abroad. With affiliations in 27 countries, ranging from Japan to Ghana, CBSE continues to uphold its commitment to transparency and safe conduct of examination.

At the Class XII level, CBSE offers 120 subjects, the highest number among any national or international board. Examinations are conducted worldwide at Indian Standard Time, ensuring uniformity and fairness.

#### **KEY HIGHLIGHTS OF 2026 EXAMINATIONS**

##### **CBSE Introduces On Screen Marking (OSM) for Class XII Evaluation-2026**

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has successfully implemented On Screen Marking (OSM) for the evaluation of Class XII answer books in the 2026 Board Examinations. CBSE has done full scale OSM in class XII which is the biggest OSM as of now. This landmark initiative reflects CBSE's commitment to transparency, efficiency, and student-centric reforms under the National Education Policy (NEP). Using OSM, CBSE has evaluated 98,66,622 answer books.

##### **Key Benefits of OSM**

- **Maintenance of Secrecy:** In this system answer books can be evaluated in any part of the country and abroad in the schools affiliated to the CBSE without physically shifting the answer books to the evaluation centres.

- **Error-Free Evaluation:** Eliminates totalling, posting, and uploading errors.
- **Complete Assessment:** Ensures every answer is evaluated as per marking scheme.
- **Reduced Human Intervention:** Minimizes manual handling, leading to fairer outcomes. Evaluator's award marks as per the marking scheme only, this assuring objective assessments.
- **Efficiency Gains:** Saves time and effort for examiners and thus more focus is on the quality assessment rather than involvement in manual work like addition and uploading of marks.
- **Eco-Friendly Digital Process:** Promotes paperless evaluation, reducing environmental impact.
- **Transparency & Accountability:** Builds trust among students, parents, and institutions.
- **Scalability:** Enables CBSE to manage evaluation of lakhs of answer books.

### **Teachers Welcome CBSE's OSM Initiative**

The introduction of On Screen Marking (OSM) by CBSE for Class XII answer book evaluation has drawn positive responses from teachers across the country. Educators see this as a transformative step that modernizes assessment practices and strengthens trust in the examination system. Teachers expressed the following views on OSM:-

- **Accuracy & Fairness:** Teachers highlight that OSM eliminates human errors in totalling and posting marks, ensuring every student's performance is reflected correctly. This also helps in quality and objective assessment of the students.
- **Transparency:** Many examiners appreciate that the digital process leaves no scope for oversight, making evaluation more accountable.
- **Efficiency:** Teachers report that OSM reduces manual workload, allowing them to focus more on academic quality rather than clerical tasks.
- **Training & Adaptability:** While initial training was required which was provided by the CBSE, however, teachers found the system user-friendly and quickly adapted to the digital interface.
- **Eco-Friendly Approach:** Educators commend CBSE's move towards paperless evaluation, aligning with sustainable practices.

- **Student Confidence:** Teachers believe that OSM reassures students and parents that results are processed with precision and fairness.

The adoption of OSM marks a paradigm shift in examination evaluation. By leveraging technology, CBSE has not only modernized its processes but also strengthened its reputation as a globally trusted education board. This initiative ensures that students receive results that are accurate, timely, and fair — reinforcing CBSE's vision of excellence in education.

### SPECIAL CONSIDERATION FOR WEST ASIAN STUDENTS

Given the prevailing situation in West Asian countries, CBSE has decided to release the results of students from this region simultaneously with other students, ensuring fairness and consistency in accordance with CBSE policy. Result of all candidates from West Asian countries where some examinations were cancelled is also being declared with the rest of the students.

## **EXAMINATION FOR THE STUDENTS WHO PARTICIPATED IN NATIONAL/ INTERNATIONAL SPORTS EVENTS**

This year, as per policy, examinations of these students were conducted on 11.04.2026 and 13.04.2026 i.e. soon after the main examinations are over.

### **PREPARATION OF DATE SHEET**

In CBSE, students can offer any combination of subjects. Accordingly, more than 40000 subject combinations were offered by the students in 2025-26 session. CBSE has declared date sheet this time much in advance as per the following details:-

1. First date Sheet was issued on 20 Oct, 2025 i.e. 109 days before the start of examinations
2. Final date sheet with minor correction was released on 31 Dec, 2025 i.e. 47 days before the start of examinations.
3. Sufficient time was given between two examinations offered by the students.
4. Examinations were also scheduled in such a manner that evaluation is over in shortest possible time after the examinations are over.
5. All dates were fixed by avoiding the date of various entrance examinations.

CBSE has issued advance date sheet to help the students in better planning for preparations of examinations. Also, schools and teachers were able to plan well to support the students in the preparations of the examinations.

### **COORDINATION WITH NTA**

NTA was provided data of such students, whose examinations were scheduled from 2.04.2026 to 08.04.2026 so that their JEE Main examination dates do not coincide with their Board examinations. NTA has fixed their examination dates by avoiding Board examination dates.

### **DEVELOPING STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES**

To ensure that all the activities of the examinations are simpler and well comprehended in the new examination environment, CBSE has revised all Standard Operating Procedures and provided to all concerned.

### **ORIENTATION OF SCHOOLS**

For holding examinations successfully, a very minute and detailed policy is prepared for the examination centres, school sponsoring the students for Boards examinations, for the parents and the students.

To ensure that this policy is followed by all correctly, a live webinar was conducted by the CBSE for all its affiliated schools on 13.02.2026. This webinar was attended by more than 30000 schools and their teachers teaching classes from Class IX to Class XII. Total number of persons who watched this live webinar were more than 4 Lakh.

In this webinar, important information regarding conduct of examinations and evaluation was communicated and the queries of participants were resolved.

### **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

Frequently Asked Questions were also developed for functionaries involved in the conduct of examinations and provided to them for better understanding of the rules and regulations for the smooth conduct of examinations.

### **COMPARING THE PERFORMANCE OF THIS BATCH**

This year, the pass percentage of students in class XII is 85.20%.

### **FEEDBACK DURING THE CONDUCT OF THE EXAMINATION**

Board has developed a very strong offline and online feedback system to get feedback on the question papers. Appropriate action has been taken by the Board on the basis of such feedback during the preparation of results.

### **SIZE OF EXAMINATION – 2026**

## **AVAILABILITY OF DOCUMENTS AFTER RESULT DECLARATION**

### **Regular students in India**

1. Performance of the students in the main examinations will be made available in their DigiLocker account.
2. To avoid the problem of accessing the DigiLocker, CBSE has provided the PIN to the schools in advance, to be given to the candidates ahead of the result declaration. Students can log in to their DigiLocker either by using their PIN or with their Aadhaar number.
3. Further, the Board will supply Printed Mark sheets cum Passing Certificates to the students through their schools.
4. Mark sheets cum Passing Certificates and Migration certificate made available in the DigiLocker shall be used for any purpose instead of printed copy of the passing documents. DigiLocker copy is legally valid for all purpose including admission in Higher Education Institutions. UGC has issued orders in this regards.

### **Regular students in Foreign Countries**

Foreign students can also get their digital documents on their emails through the CBSE DigiLocker page. Their Printed Mark sheets cum Passing Certificates will be supplied through their schools.

### **To the private students**

1. Private students will also be provided electronic documents in their DigiLocker which could be accessed through their Aadhaar number.
2. Except for the students of the Regional Office, Delhi East and Delhi West, printed documents will be sent to the address given in the examination form. For the students of Delhi East and Delhi West, printed documents will be available at the examination centre from where they have appeared in the examinations.

## **NO MERIT LIST**

As per the earlier decision of the Board to avoid unhealthy competition amongst the students, no merit list is declared by the CBSE. Also, Board does not award first, second or third divisions to its students.

However, the Board will issue the merit certificate to top 0.1% of students who have scored the highest marks in the subjects. The Merit certificate will be made available in the Digi-Locker of the student.

### **POST RESULT DECLARATION FACILITIES**

Though, the CBSE has a well developed and reliable system of evaluation, however, CBSE provides a transparent policy where in students who are not satisfied with their performance informed in result may avail **POST RESULT DECLARATION FACILITIES**. In 2026, as CBSE has digitally evaluated answer book, hence, there is no requirement to address totaling and posting errors. However, re-evaluation facilities will be extended as per earlier years.

Post Result Declaration Facilities will start from **18.05.2026**. A detailed circular will be issued shortly and separately. These facilities can only be availed online. Students are advised to follow the schedule strictly as no application will be accepted after the last date and against the guidelines issued in this regard.

### **SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS**

Supplementary examinations will be conducted on **15.07.2026**. This would be a single day examination. The following category of students will be allowed to appear in this examination:-

1. Candidates who have passed Class XII in 2026 and wish to improve their performance in one subject only.
2. Candidates who have appeared in Class XII in 2026 and placed in Compartment Category.
3. Candidates who have appeared in Class XII in 2025 and placed in Compartment Category. As 03 opportunities are given to clear the Compartment, hence, this examination would be the last opportunity for these students.

### **LOC SUBMISSION FOR THE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS**

Candidates who wish to improve their performance after passing main examinations and candidates who are placed in compartment category in the main examinations-2026, LOC will start from **02.06.2026**. A detailed circular will be issued shortly and separately. LOC will be filled in only online. No change i.e, addition or deletion of name, addition or deletion of subjects once the LOC is submitted will be accepted by the Board. Schools and students are advised to follow the schedule strictly as no application will be accepted after the last date and against the guidelines issued in this regard.
