- Comparative Performance Insights: The report benchmarks the school's academic outcomes
 against state-level and Overall CBSE Board School averages across subjects, helping schools
 identify relative strengths and improvement areas. It also highlights performance trends among
 male and female students, enabling schools to take informed steps toward ensuring gender
 equity in learning outcomes.
- Holistic Performance Indicators: Beyond academics, the report also captures school-level participation and achievements in sports and games, benchmarked against performance at the cluster and zonal levels.

Through this initiative, CBSE aims to empower schools with actionable insights to foster continuous improvement and enhance student learning outcomes. Schools are encouraged to review their report cards carefully, identify focus areas, and integrate the findings into their School Annual Pedagogical Plans.

Heads of Institutions can access their respective School Academic Performance Report Card through the CBSE School Login Portal using their credentials.
