(Private students have to submit the examination form on the CBSE portal personally within schedule)

Subject:- Online submission of forms by Private Candidates of Class XII, Supplementary Examination- 2026 for Compartment (3rd chance) reg.

As the Board has declared the results of class XII, the process for submission of Examination Form for Supplementary Examination for Class XII for session 2025-26 shall start **w.e.f. 30.06.2026 (Tuesday)**. The submission of applications for appearing in Supplementary Examination 2026 is to be done through the link given on CBSE Website <https://cbse.gov.in>.

1. This circular is for the following candidates:-

Regular students of 2025 placed in Compartment Category (3rd chance) can apply only as Private category

Only those private students who submit the online application form alongwith the prescribed fees shall be allowed to appear for Supplementary Examinations, 2026.

2. Before filling the application form:-

- Students who have appeared for the Board's Examinations as regular students in the session 2024-25 or as private students in the session 2025-26 and whose result has been declared as '**Compartment**' should apply through online mode.
- Kindly submit your candidature within schedule as no candidature will be accepted once schedule is over.**

3. The private students shall submit application forms for Supplementary Examinations- 2026 as per the **conditions of eligibility** given in **Annexure-1**.


5. Consolidated mark sheet will be issued only to the students whose result was declared COMPARTMENT in Board's Examinations 2026 and who will be declared Pass in Supplementary Examinations 2026.

6. The Supplementary Examinations-2026 will be conducted based on the Syllabus prescribed for the Board examinations for session 2025-26, which is available on the CBSE website.

7. The application forms shall be filled as per the current status of the result of the candidates.

8. The schedule of Supplementary Examinations:- **Supplementary Examination for class XII will be held on 28 July 2026 (Tuesday).**

9. The dates for download of Admit Cards will be informed separately. In case of any discrepancy in the Admit card, the candidates should contact the concerned Regional Office of the Board immediately.

ANNEXURE 1

FOR PRIVATE STUDENTS	
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS - 2026	
ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: CLASS XII	
A.	Students who appeared under the category "Private" in full subjects (05) in Board's Examinations, 2026 and result declared as COMPARTMENT are eligible to apply only in one subject in which placed in Compartment.
B.	Students who appeared under the category "Private" in Board's Examinations, 2026 with 6 Subjects and placed in compartment in two subjects, are eligible to apply in any one of the two subjects.
C.	Students, who appeared under category "Private" in Board's Examinations, 2026 with 6 subjects and declared PASS but could not clear one subject, are eligible to apply in the failed subject under the Improvement of the Performance category only in the subjects whose examinations will be conducted.
D.	Students who appeared in Board's Examinations, 2025 and result declared as COMPARTMENT, again placed in "COMPARTMENT category at the 1st chance in Compartment Examination 2025 and yet again in 2nd chance Compartment Examination with Board examinations 2026 are eligible to apply only in one subject in which placed in Compartment, 2026 for 3rd and final chance in Supplementary Examinations-2026. The 3rd chance in Supplementary Examinations 2026 will be the last chance for the student who appeared for Board's Examinations 2025.

- D. No application will be accepted after the last date with/without fee in any manner offline/online mode.

FEE PAYMENT METHOD

A.	<p><u>Fee for all activities is accepted only through digital payments modes as per the below given details by CBSE:-</u></p> <p>In India - Debit Card / Credit Card / Net Banking/ UPI</p> <p>Foreign - Debit Card / Credit Card / Net Banking.</p> <p>PAY THE FEE IN SUCH A WAY THAT IT IS TRANSFERED IN BOARD'S ACCOUNT ON OR BEFORE THE LAST DATE OF SUBMISSION OF LOC. IF LOC FILLED BUT FEE NOT PAID. CANDIDATURE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND NOT ALLOWED TO APPEAR IN SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS.</p>
B.	<p>Before payment of the fee, schools can take the print of LOC in the form of a checklist. Once the fee is paid, the final LOC will be printed, and no correction could be made in the online or offline mode thereafter.</p>
C.	<p>It is the responsibility of the school to ensure that fee is in such a manner that it is updated in Board's account on or before the last date. In case of Bank related transactions or non-updation of Fees on the server, the schools should contact the respective bank through which payment was made.
