17. Epidermis:- It is the outermost layer of skin also called Epithelium .It is a waterproof protective shield which protects our body from infections. There are no blood vessels in this layer. It is nourished by the dermis. 4

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Dermis:- It is just below the epidermis and is made up of dense connective tissues containing blood vessels, nerves, collagen, elastin fiber, hair follicles and sweat glands. It also provides strength and nourishment to the skin.

2. Correct ratio should be maintained.
