5. **JNV Special Selection Test for Class VI:** Special Selection Test was held on 23rd August, 2025 for admission to Class VI for the year 2025 against vacant seats in 18 JNVs of NVS Regional Office Shillong in 03 languages i.e. English, Mizo and Garo for an estimated number of 5000 candidates.

Despite a challenging timeline, all critical tasks including the finalization, printing, and packaging of Question Papers (QPs) and OMR sheets were completed within one month. As per the agreed schedule, CBSE ensured timely dispatch of confidential examination material to the NVS Headquarters.

6. **SHRESHTA Scheme:** Each year a specified number of meritorious SC students in States/UTs are selected through the National Entrance Test for SHRESTHA conducted by the NTA and admitted in the best private residential schools identified based on the database of the CBSE. A list of CBSE Affiliated Residential Schools identified for the Shreshta Scheme for the year 2025-26, basing on the criteria as prescribed by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India.

7. **PARAKH RASHTRIYA SARVEKSHAN 2024:**

- The Ministry of Education entrusted the task of conducting the **PARAKH Rashtriya Sarvekshan – 2024 to PARAKH-NCERT and CBSE.**
- One of the largest nationwide samples based educational surveys conducted across the country to provide structured feedback on student learning levels at District, State & National Levels.
- The survey covered **87,619 sample schools** across **782 districts** in the country.
- CBSE's role was to act as the **assessment test administrator.**
- The objective was to assess nearly **23 lakh students** from **Grades 3, 6, and 9.**
- Students were assessed on grade-specific competencies in **23 languages.**
- The survey was successfully conducted on **December 4, 2024**, in **781 districts.**
- It could not be conducted in **Villupuram district, Tamil Nadu** due to severe flooding, closure of all schools as per orders from local authorities following a cyclone.
