CBSE maintains the exhaustive information pertaining to the examination, details of the school affiliated with it and the information related to its activity. All such information excluding the confidential information is made accessible to the public through NIC portal.

The information pertaining to the result, admit card and roll No. etc is accessible to the public on production of roll No., date of Birth and the application form no. as the case may be.

Besides forms like Duplicate Marksheet, Certificate, Migration Certificate are available of the website in downloadable mode.

CBSE has also made available information through digital initiatives. The details are as under:-

- (i) **A CBSE Academic Repository:** Developed in technical collaboration with NEGD, first of its kind online academic repository. Students can also download their academic awards such as Marks sheets, Migration Certificates and Pass Certificates through this repository. Academic documents are made available through digital lockers to each and every student.
- (ii) **Digital Locker - CBSE on Board** opened **approx. 80 lakhs** digital lockers of class X & XII students and pushed digitally signed marks sheets, migration certificates and pass certificates with PKI based QR Codes.
- (iii) **CBSE Academic Repository “परिणाममंजूषा”** has been integrated with ‘e-Sanad’ portal of MEA for online authentication of academic records for students going abroad for higher studies or employment.
