

2. The Technical and Financial Bids be kept in two separate envelopes and both envelopes be kept in another big envelope duly sealed and superscribed "Tender for the Hiring of hand Bug/Metal Detector" and addressed to the Secretary, CBSE, Shiksha Kendra, 2, Community Centre, Preet Vihar, Delhi-110301. 3. The terms and conditions duly signed by the Tenderers should accompany the specific Tender Form.
4. The Earnest Money of the Tender is Rs.5,00,000/- in the form of Bank Draft or FDRs or Bank Guarantee valid upto 135 days in favour of the Secretary, CBSE, Preet Vihar, Delhi from any of the scheduled Commercial Banks.
5. The validity of the bid and rates shall be for 90 days from the date of opening of financial bids. The EMD shall remain valid for a period of 45 days beyond the final Bid validity period.
6. Those registered with the Central Purchase Organization, National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or the concerned Ministry or Deptt. are exempted for submission of the earnest money. The tender should invariably accompany the proof to this effect.
7. Tenders received after expiry of date, time and those without EMD shall be rejected summarily. Technical bids will be opened on the same date i.e 04.03.2016 at 3.00 pm in the presence of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives, who may like to be present.
8. Technical Bid shall be evaluated by a Committee constituted for the purpose. The technically qualified bidder shall be considered for opening of their Financial Bids.
9. Conditional bid or bid making counter offer shall not be accepted and will be summarily rejected.
10. Canvassing for the tender in any form is strictly prohibited and shall lead to summary rejection of the tender.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The service provider should have its own infrastructure/ authorised representative of manufacturer for providing services for hiring of highly sensitive hand held metal/bug detector and manpower to make available at designated City Coordinator Centre (Annexure VII & VIII) for onward distribution to the Examinations Centre at least 5 days before the date of examination.
2. The service provider shall be responsible to take all clearances, certificates, licenses and should comply with all statutory obligations required for undertaking/providing services with regard to the transportation, use and collection of Bug/Metal detector.
3. There shall be no change in price structure during the currency of contract except of the statutory levies which are made applicable by the Govt. through notification/regulations change.
4. The assignment will be time bound, and the agency shall ensure successful completion of delivery as per schedule. The observance of time schedule is an essential element of this contract.
5. Agency shall maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality and will not divulge any information relating to assignment or examination to any third party, person, individual or boy corporate.
6. The validity of the Bid shall be for 90 days from the date of opening of Financial Bid. However, the Chairman, CBSE in exceptional may extend the validity period of Bid and that shall be binding on the Bidders.
7. Any discrepancy or failure to comply with requirement of CBSE, in the assignment, will be the sole responsibility of the agency and any lapse shall lead to forfeiture of performance security and penal/legal action against the agency, beside appropriate compensation towards loss incurred by CBSE.
8. CBSE will not be responsible for any damages of any Bug/Metal Detector provided at the examination centres by the service provider and the agency shall be fully responsible for safety and security of its equipment /infrastructure/manpower.
9. The agency shall be informed in advance the details regarding the number of Bug/Metal Detector for hiring at respective city coordinator centres. The list of examination centres will be shared at appropriate time.
10. There should not be any over writing or amendment in the rates quoted, the terms and conditions of the contract. All the forms should be duly signed with seal of the firm.
11. Three (03) Bug/Metal Detector must be enclosed as the specifications samples in the Tender and stating the Brand Name on the body of sample for which the rates for hiring have been quoted. The sample Bug/Metal Detector shall be returned to all the bidders along with EMD except the successful service provider. Tender submitted without samples will be summarily rejected.
12. The rates should strictly be in accordance with the specifications and terms specified in the Tender Form. Submission of incomplete Tender or for different specifications other than the specifications mentioned in the Tender Form and without sample shall be 'rejected'.
13. The delivery/collection of the Bug/Metal Detector shall be at/from the City Coordinator Centre situated throughout the country or at any other location in the NCR of Delhi/New Delhi in the manner specified in the supply order. The service provider shall ensure timely delivery of the Bug/Metal Detector at the City Coordinator Centres. No extra payment/charges incurred as a

consequence of wrong delivery/mis-interpretation of the terms and conditions of agreement or otherwise shall be allowed or permitted. The list of City Coordinator for AIPMT and JEE (Main) is attached as annexure VII & VIII of the Tender Document.

14. The packing should be in a packet containing the required number of Bug/Metal Detector for the City Coordinator Centre and ensure delivery in a cardboard box or in any appropriate packing in working condition at City Coordinators centres in accordance with the packing statement prescribed by the Board.
15. In the event of failure of the delivery of Bug/Metal Detector (on hiring basis) by the firm as per terms and conditions, the Board reserves the right to hire metal detector from any other source at the supplier's risk and expenses and the firm shall be liable for any consequent loss incurred to the Board for this reason. In case of any dispute regarding imposition of penalty, forfeiture of Performance Security on account of violation of terms & conditions, the decision of the Chairman of the Board shall be final and binding upon the Tenderer.
16. The successful service provider shall have to enter into an agreement in the prescribed form on a non-judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 100/- along with Performance Security equal to 10% of the work order value within a week's time from the date of placement of the order and in case of failure to do so, the Chairman of the Board shall have right to cancel the hiring order and forfeit the Earnest Money.
17. The Performance Security shall be 10% of the total contract value in favour of "The Secretary, CBSE" and shall be in the form of Demand Draft/FDR or Bank Guarantee and shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty obligations. The EMD shall be refunded on receipt of Performance Security of successful bidder. EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded after notification of the work order.
18. The Board shall take random samples from the hired Bug/Metal Detector for confirmation of the technical specifications of the hired detectors. Deviations in the specifications may render the entire service contract for rejection. The Chairman, CBSE, in the case of deviation of specifications, may impose penalty of 2.5% per specification/deviation on the bill amount subject to maximum penalty of 30 percent. The decision of the Chairman, CBSE shall be final and binding on the service provider.
19. No advance payment shall be made to the agency, however, whole payment shall be released, after satisfactory completion of the Board's Examination/Test. The payment shall be made strictly on the basis of report of successful working of equipments received from all the city coordinators.
20. In case of default on any terms specified and/or in the event of non-fulfilment of the contract or otherwise, the performance security shall be forfeited.
21. Canvassing in any form shall be a disqualification and the Board reserves the right to reject the tender of such party/parties straight away without assigning any reasons.
22. The rates shall be inclusive of all Taxes, charges, levies and other indirect/incidental charges such as cartage/transportation/labour charges incurred by the supplier for successful delivery at city coordinators centres or at any designated place in NCR of Delhi.
23. The packing of Bug/Metal Detector should be strictly as per the Board's requirement and shall be mentioned in the work order.
24. Quantity of Bug/Metal detector be accounted on the basis of total metal detectors supplied to the designated city coordinator.

25. The successful bidder will have to complete the supply of hired Bug/Metal Detector within the period as may be specified in the work order at the designated City Coordinator Centre.
26. Timely delivery of Bug/Metal Detector being the essential element of the contract. A penalty of @ 4% per day shall be levied in case the metal detectors are not made available in accordance with the given delivery time schedule subject to a maximum penalty of 20% of the amount of the Bill.
27. The Tenderer shall sign at the space specified as a token of acceptance of these terms and conditions, which shall be final and legally binding on him in totality.
28. The Chairman, CBSE shall have the right to accept any tender in whole or part or reject it entirely without assigning any reason.
29. No change of rates shall be allowed during the contract period, which is 1 year from the date of placing order, except for taxes levied by Govt.
30. The agreement/work order for hiring of Bug/Metal Detector can be extended upto another two year by mutual consent on satisfactory performance of the contract on similar rates and terms and conditions of the agreement subject to the conditions that the successful bidder give a certificate that they had not provided the Bug/Metal Detector for hiring of same specification on lower rates to any other person, individual, organization or body corporate and that there is no downward trend in the hiring price Bug/Metal Detector in the market.
31. Taxes as applicable shall be deducted on all the bills.
32. In case of any dispute, the legal jurisdiction shall be of courts having jurisdiction within the Union Territory of Delhi/New Delhi.
33. In case of any dispute arising under this contract, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitration of Chairman, CBSE or any person nominated by him in this regard. The award made by the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
34. The Bug/Metal Detector provided for frisking should be able to detect any prohibited metallic/electronics devices at examination centres on the day of examination as the per the requirement. Adequate quantity of spare sets shall also be kept at the City Coordinator Centre to account for any technical glitches/non working of the provided metal detectors or in emergency.
35. The selected agency will organize required manpower at all the City coordinator Centres/Delhi to provide demonstration to CBSE Teams on duty how to handle the detector and explain the functioning of detectors.
36. The CBSE will not be responsible for any loss/damage to any Bug/Metal Detector during use at the examination centres or during transportation by the agency and the agency shall be fully responsible for safety and security of its metal detector/manpower.
37. The list of the examination centres will be shared by the Board at appropriate time and the firm shall maintain complete secrecy regarding the examination centres and the use of metal detector by the Board.
