TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The Bug/Metal Detector provided for frisking should be able to detect any prohibited metallic/electronics devices/copper/aluminium/silver etc. wire/cell battery/watch battery/miniature electronic gadget/photovoltaic equipment or similar material at examination centres on the day of examination as per the requirement schedule (Annexure-III).
- 2. The bidder should have its own infrastructure/authorised representative of manufacturer of highly sensitive hand held metal/bug detector and manpower to make available at designated City location (Annexure VII) for onward distribution to the Examinations Centre at least 3 days before the date of examination.
- 3. The bidder shall be responsible to take all clearances, certificates, licenses and should comply with all statutory obligations required for undertaking/providing services with regard to the transportation and use of Bug/Metal detector.
- 4. There shall be no change in price structure during the currency of contract.
- 5. The assignment will be time bound, and the agency shall ensure successful completion of delivery as per schedule. The observance of time schedule is an essential element of this contract.
- 6. Agency shall maintain strict secrecy and confidentiality and will not divulge any information relating to assignment or examination to any third party, person, individual or boy corporate.
- 7. The validity of the Bid shall be for 90 days from the date of opening of Financial Bid. However, the validity period of bid can be extended with mutual consent if required.
- 8. Any discrepancy or failure to comply with requirement of CBSE, in the assignment, will be the sole responsibility of the agency and any lapse shall lead to forfeiture of performance security and penal/legal action against the agency, beside appropriate compensation towards loss incurred by CBSE.
- 9. The agency shall be informed in advance the details regarding the number of Bug/Metal Detector to be delivered at respective city locations centres. The list of address of designated city locations will be shared at appropriate time.
- 10. There should not be any over writing or amendment in the rates quoted, the terms and conditions of the contract. All the forms should be duly signed with seal of the firm.
- 11. Three (03) Bug/Metal Detector must be submitted as the per specifications samples in the Tender and stating the Brand Name on the body of sample for which the rates for supply have been quoted alongwith the technical bid. The sample of Bug/Metal Detector shall be returned to all the bidders along with EMD except the successful bidder. Tender submitted without samples will be summarily rejected.
- 12. The rates should strictly be in accordance with the specifications and terms specified in the Tender Form. Submission of incomplete Tender or for different specifications other than the specifications mentioned in the Tender Form and without sample shall be 'rejected'.
- 13. The delivery (Annexure-VII) of the Bug/Metal Detector shall be within the period as may be specified in the work order at the designated City locations situated throughout the country or at any other location in the NCR of Delhi/New Delhi in the manner specified in the supply order. The bidder shall ensure timely delivery of the Bug/Metal Detector at the designated City locations Centres. No extra payment/charges incurred as a consequence of

- wrong delivery/mis-interpretation of the terms and conditions of agreement or otherwise shall be allowed or permitted. The list of City locations is attached as annexure VII of the Tender Document.
- 14. The packing should be in a packet containing the required number of Bug/Metal Detector for the City locations and ensure delivery in a cardboard box or in any appropriate packing in working condition at City Designated city locations in accordance with the packing statement prescribed by the Board.
- 15. In the event of failure of the delivery of Bug/Metal Detector by the firm as per terms and conditions, the Board reserves the right to procure metal detector from any other source at the supplier's risk and expenses and the firm shall be liable for any consequent loss incurred to the Board for this reason. In case of any dispute regarding imposition of penalty, forfeiture of Performance Security on account of violation of terms & conditions, the decision of the Chairman of the Board shall be final and binding upon the Tenderer.
- 16. The successful bidder shall have to enter into an agreement in the prescribed form on a non-judicial Stamp Paper of Rs. 100/- along with Performance Security equal to 10% of the work order value within a week's time from the date of placement of the order and in case of failure to do so, the Chairman of the Board shall have right to cancel the purchase order and forfeit the Earnest Money.
- 17. The Performance Security being 10% of the total contract value in favour of The Secretary, CBSE shall be in the form of Demand Draft/FDR/Bank Guarantee and shall remain valid for a period of 60 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations including warranty obligations. The EMD shall be refunded on receipt of Performance Security of successful bidder. EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be refunded after notification of the work order.
- 18. The Board shall take random samples from the purchased Bug/Metal Detector for confirmation of the technical specifications of the supplied detectors. Deviations in the specifications may render the entire service contract for rejection. The Chairman, CBSE, in the case of deviation of specifications, may impose penalty of 2.5% per specification/deviation on the bill amount subject to maximum penalty of 30 percent. The decision of the Chairman, CBSE shall be final and binding on the bidder.
- 19. No advance payment shall be made to the agency; however, payment shall be released, after delivery of the metal detectors at designated city locations and satisfactory conduct of the Board's Examination/Test. The payment shall be made strictly on the basis of report of successful working of equipments received from all the city locations and confirmation of specifications of supplied detectors.
- 20. In case of default on any terms specified and/or in the event of non-fulfilment of the contract or otherwise, the performance security shall be forfeited.
- 21. Canvassing in any form shall be a disqualification and the Board reserves the right to reject the tender of such party/parties straight away without assigning any reasons.
- 22. The rates shall be inclusive of all Taxes, charges, levies and other indirect/incidental charges such as cartage/transportation/labour charges incurred by the supplier for successful delivery at designated city locations or at any designated place in NCR of Delhi.
- 23. The packing of Bug/Metal Detector should be strictly as per the Board's requirement and shall be mentioned in the work order.
- 24. Quantity of Bug/Metal detector be accounted on the basis of total metal detectors supplied to the designated city locations.
- 25. Timely delivery of Bug/Metal Detector being the essential element of the contract. A penalty of @ 4% per day shall be levied in case the metal

- detectors are not made available in accordance with the given delivery time schedule subject to a maximum penalty of 10% of the amount of the Bill.
- 26. The Tenderer shall sign at the space specified as a token of acceptance of these terms and conditions, which shall be final and legally binding on him in totality.
- 27. The Chairman, CBSE shall have the right to accept any tender in whole or part or reject it entirely without assigning any reason.
- 28. No change of rates shall be allowed during the contract period, which is 1 year from the date of placing order.
- 29.
